NOTICE OF VOLUNTARY CAMPAIGN EXPENDITURE LIMITS
FOR CITY COUNCIL CANDIDATES**

The City of Redwood City is committed to preserving integrity and openness in the political process as a matter of the highest public interest. To this end, the City has adopted a local campaign finance ordinance which sets mandatory campaign contribution limits and voluntary campaign expenditure limits for City Council candidates.

For the **November 3, 2026** City Council election, the voluntary campaign expenditure ceiling is **\$2.58** per resident in each electoral district. Residency of each electoral district has been determined by the latest decennial census population figures available for each district, as illustrated below.
