Health and Safety Requirements (Facility):

Pass Fail N/A checkboxes

A recognizable and legible sign is posted at the main entrance of the massage business identifying the business as such business. The sign matches the name of the business on file. (RCC 18A.12)

Pass Fail N/A checkboxes

The hours of operation of no earlier than seven o'clock (7:00) A.M and no later than ten o'clock (10:00) P.M. is displayed in a conspicuous public place in the reception area and in any front window clearly visible from outside of the massage business. (RCC 18A.10.C.5)

Pass Fail N/A checkboxes

The massage business, if located in a building or structure with exterior windows fronting a public street, highway, walkway, or parking area, does not block visibility into the interior reception and waiting area through the use of curtains, closed blinds, tints, or any other material that obstructs, blurs or darkens the view into the premises. (RCC 18A.10.A.7)

Pass Fail N/A checkboxes

One (1) front door is provided for patron entry to the massage business, which shall open to an interior patron reception and waiting area immediately inside the front door. All patrons and any persons other than individuals employed or retained by the massage business shall be required to enter and exit through the front. (RCC 18A.10.A.6)

Pass Fail N/A checkboxes

Registration Certificate displayed in an accessible and conspicuous place on the premises. (RCC 18A.12)

Pass Fail N/A checkboxes

A list of services available and the cost of such services is posted, in English, in an open and conspicuous public place on the premises. No massage business operator shall permit, and no person employed or retained by the Certified Massage Business shall offer to perform, any services or fees other than those posted. (RCC 18A.10.C.6)

Pass Fail N/A checkboxes

Security deposit facilities for the protection of the valuables of the patrons are available. (RCC 18A.10.A.5)

Pass Fail N/A checkboxes

Dressing and locker facilities are provided for patrons. (RCC 18A.10.A.5)

Pass Fail N/A checkboxes

One (1) artificial white light of not less than forty (40) watts or equivalent is provided in each room where massage is administered. (RCC 18A.10.A.1)

Pass Fail N/A checkboxes

The walls are clean and painted with an approved washable mold resistant paint in all rooms where water or steam baths are given. (RCC 18A.10.A.2)



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Floors are free from any accumulation of dust, dirt, or refuse. (RCC 18A.10.A.3)

All equipment used in the massage operation is maintained in a clean and sanitary condition. (RCC 18A.10.A.4)

Health and Safety Requirements (Linens):

Pass Fail N/A

Towels, sheets, clothes and linens of all types, and items for personal use of operators and patrons are clean and freshly laundered and are not used for more than one (1) person. (RCC 18A.10.B.1)

Reuse of such items is prohibited unless the same has first been laundered. Such items are not laundered or dried in any massage business unless the business is provided with approved laundry facilities for such laundering and drying. (RCC 18A.10.B.2)

Heavy white paper may be substituted for sheets provided that such paper is used once for every person and then discarded into a sanitary receptacle. (RCC 18A.10.B.3)

Health and Safety Requirements (Personnel):

Pass Fail N/A

If during the life of a Certificate of Registration, the applicant has any change in information concerning the original application, notification must be made to the Chief of Police, in writing, within ten (10) days of the change. (Check massage practitioners present to employees listed in application.) (RCC 18A.10.C.4)

Employee	CAMTC License	CAMTC Certificate

All massage technicians/practitioners have California Massage Therapy Council (CAMTC) license in possession while providing massage services. (BP 4603.7)



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- All massage practitioners shall display their original CAMTC certificate at his or her place of business. (Look for gold embossed seal). (BP 4603.7)
- Sole Proprietor does not have other massage technicians working on premises. (RCC 18A.4.A)
- No person afflicted with an infection or parasitic infestation transmissible to a patron shall knowingly provide massage therapy to a patron, or remain on the premises of a Certified Massage Business while so infected or infested. (RCC 18A.10.C.1)
- It shall be unlawful for any Certified Massage Practitioner or other person to massage the genital area of any patron or the breasts of any female patron or for any operator of a massage business to allow or permit such massage. (RCC 18A.10.C.2)
- It shall be unlawful for any Certified Massage Practitioner or other person to be other than fully clothed in non-transparent clothing at all times that shall not expose their genitals, pubic area, buttocks, or chest or for any operator of a massage business to allow or permit prohibited dress. (RCC 18A.10.C.3)
