## ANIMAL REGULATIONS



The City of Redwood City has numerous ordinances concerning animal control and regulations. Our City has adopted San Mateo County's ordinances, Chapter 6, and has specifically addressed other issues for a safer environment of its residents and animals.

**Fowl and rabbits (RCC 5.26)** Roosters, Pigeons, Ducks, Geese, Turkeys, or similar fowl are **prohibited** in Redwood City. A maximum of three (3) chickens and/or Rabbits can be maintained in a confined coop or cage. Maintenance of any of the above mentioned animals or fowl require the responsible party to properly clean the area on a continuous basis.

**Maintenance of Dogs and Cats (RCC 5.2)** Each household is authorized to keep up to 4 animals: dogs and Cats or a combination of both. It is **PROHIBITED** to have more than 2 Dogs. Each owner is responsible for the maintenance of his/her own dog or cat.

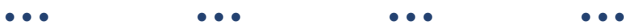
**Animal Waste (RCC 5.6)** Animal waste matter **MUST BE** removed in a safe and sanitary manner from any private or public property.

**Exotic Animals (RCC 5.3)** The following animals are prohibited in Redwood City: Stallion, Swine, Bull, Ram, Billy Goat, Monkey, reptile or any animal not commonly domesticated. No animal shall be kept within the city other than those specifically mentioned in the city ordinances.

**Barking Dogs which disturb the peace of any citizen are prohibited. Noise complaints, please contact the Redwood City Police Department (650)780-7100.**

**Animal rescue, animal control and animal cruelty investigations, please contact Peninsula Humane Society (650) 340-7022.**

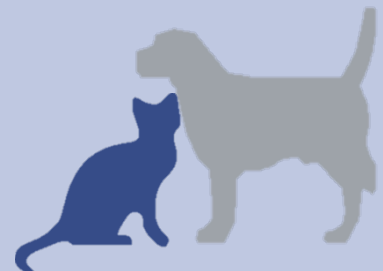
### Code Enforcement Mission Statement
