## ILLEGAL DUMPING

Redwood City’s Code Enforcement staff reminds the community that it is illegal to dump or leave household goods or clothes, even as a donation, in a location that does not accept such items, or at a time when such donations are not acceptable. These items often do not find their way to those in-need, and they are also an eyesore, foster further unlawful dumping of garbage and other materials, and create a habitat for rodents and other pests.



No person shall dump, place or bury in any lot, land, street or alley, or in any water or waterway or elsewhere within the city any garbage, trash, rubbish, or manure, or any waste manner condemned by the Health Department or its authorized representatives.

(RCC Sec. 14.5)

Any person violating any of the above mentioned Redwood City code section may be guilty of an infraction and cited respectively or cited administratively with fines.

All residents including Landlords are responsible for keeping the frontage of our community clean. Twice a year, Recology offers a scheduled pickup service for their customers who have large items they don’t need any more and that are too large for the carts; contact **Recology of San Mateo County** at (650) 595-3900 for more information or go to [www.recycleworks.org](http://www.recycleworks.org) for information about how and where to recycle a variety of materials.
