



# Building Electrification Rebate Program

Rebated amounts are effective July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026.

All Redwood City Homeowners are eligible, multiple rebates available

## Rebates are now available for electrifying your home!

- Replace your gas water heater with a **Heat Pump Hot Water Heater** and receive \$500
- Replace your gas furnace and air conditioner or wall furnace and window air conditioner with a **High-Efficiency Heat Pump** and receive \$500
- Up to \$500 to upgrade your electrical panel, if required for new heat pump equipment
- Additional \$500 for customers enrolled in CARE<sup>1</sup>/FERA<sup>2</sup>/WSRAP<sup>3</sup> income-qualified utility bill discount programs

**Rebate Limits:**  
Limit of one application with up to three (3) rebates per residential unit

## Terms & Conditions

- Rebates are distributed on a first-come, first-served basis until all funds are expended or through the program expiration date of June 30, 2026, whichever comes first.
- Rebates are available for Heat Pump Hot Water Heaters, High-Efficiency Heat Pumps, and electrical panel upgrades required for new equipment. CARE/FERA/WSRAP customers participating in the Building Electrification Rebate Program are eligible for an additional \$500 to defray permitting costs.
- Applicant must provide equipment receipt(s) or paid invoice(s), installation receipt(s) or paid electrician's invoice(s) with electrician's license number, photo(s) of installed equipment, and permit number(s). If applicant submits original receipt(s) and needs them returned, they must enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope with their application. Applicant must be able to provide proof of home ownership. Product(s) must be new, and installation must be permitted by the City of Redwood City.
- Limit of one rebate application per residential unit.
- Rebates may take up to eight (8) weeks to process.
- Rebates are issued as checks.

## To Be Eligible for the Program

- Applicant must complete and sign the Building Electrification Rebate application and provide all requested material.
- Applicant must be a Redwood City homeowner. To ensure eligibility for rebate, verify eligibility with Public Works Services BEFORE purchasing new equipment.
- The equipment must be purchased between July 1, 2025 and June 30, 2026. Installation must be permitted by the City of Redwood City. The rebate application must be submitted within 90 days of equipment installation date.

## BUILDING ELECTRIFICATION REBATE PROGRAM APPLICANT CHECKLIST
