

Electric Leaf Blower Commercial Rebate Amounts

Rebated amount is effective July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026.

- **Newly purchased electric leaf blower – up to \$300**

REDWOOD CITY BUSINESSES ARE ELIGIBLE

Businesses with active Redwood City business licenses are eligible for rebate amounts of up to \$300 off one newly purchased electric leaf blower (and optional battery).

Rebate Limits:

Limit of one rebate per active Redwood City business license.

Terms & Conditions

- Rebates are distributed on a first-come, first-served basis until all funds are expended or through the program expiration date of June 30, 2026, whichever comes first.
- Rebates are for \$300 off a newly purchased electric leaf blower or leaf blower and battery.
- To be eligible for the rebate, applicant must have an active Redwood City business license, complete and sign the rebate application form, provide a copy of the original equipment receipt, and provide photo(s) of leaf blower (and battery, if applicable) and/or equipment box showing equipment name with the rebate application.
- Limit of one rebate per active Redwood City business license.
- Rebates may take up to eight (8) weeks to process.
- Rebates are issued as checks to the business listed in the application.

To Be Eligible for the Program

- To ensure eligibility for rebate, verify eligibility with Public Works Services BEFORE purchasing new equipment.
- The electric leaf blower must be purchased between July 1, 2025 and June 30, 2026. The electric leaf blower rebate application must be submitted within 90 days of electric leaf blower purchase date.
- A copy of the original electric leaf blower purchase receipt must be included with the application. If applicant submits original receipt(s) and needs them returned, they must enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope with their application.
- Mail or turn in application, original receipt, and photo(s) to Public Works Services, 1400 Broadway, Redwood City, CA 94063, or email application and receipt to climateactionplan@redwoodcity.org.
