

Electric Vehicle (EV) Charger Rebate Amount

Rebated amount is effective July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026.

- **Newly purchased and installed Level 2 EV Charger – \$500**

ALL RESIDENTS OF REDWOOD CITY ARE ELIGIBLE

for rebate amounts of \$500 for one newly purchased and installed Level 2 EV Charger, per residential unit.

Rebate Limits:
Limit of one rebate per residential utility account

Terms & Conditions

- Rebates are distributed on a first-come, first-served basis until all funds are expended or through the program expiration date of June 30, 2026, whichever comes first.
- Rebates are \$500 for one newly purchased and installed Level 2 EV Charger per residential unit. A Charger with multiple ports, or plugs, is considered one unit and is eligible for a single rebate.
- Product(s) must be new, and installation must be permitted by the City of Redwood City.
- Limit of one rebate per residential utility account.
- Rebates may take up to eight (8) weeks to process.
- Rebates are issued as checks.

To Be Eligible for the Program

- Applicant must complete and sign the EV Charger rebate application and provide all requested material.
- Applicant must be a Redwood City resident. Applicant must provide a residential utility bill as proof of Redwood City residency. To ensure eligibility for rebate, verify eligibility with Public Works Services BEFORE purchasing new equipment.
- If applicant is not the property owner and is not listed on the utility account, applicant must provide the property owner or account holder's contact information.
- The EV Charger must be purchased between July 1, 2025 and June 30, 2026. Product(s) must be new, and installation must be permitted. The EV Charger rebate application must be submitted within 90 days of EV Charger installation date.
- A copy of the original EV Charger purchase receipt must be included with the application. If applicant submits original receipt(s) and needs them returned, they must enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope with their application.
- A copy of the installation receipt or paid electrician's invoice, with the electrician's license number, and photo of installed EV Charger must be included with the application.
- A copy of the final, signed building permit or permit number must be included with the application.
