

Electric Lawn Care Equipment & Electric Leaf Blower Rebate

Rebated amount is effective July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026

- **Newly purchased electric lawn care equipment (string trimmers, hedge trimmers, edgers, or tiller/cultivators) and/or electric leaf blower – up to \$150 each rebate type (2 rebates total)**

ALL RESIDENTS OF REDWOOD CITY ARE ELIGIBLE

for rebate amounts of up to \$150 off newly purchased electric lawn care equipment and/or an electric leaf blower, up to a maximum of \$150 each rebate type (up to \$300 total)

Rebate Limits:

Limit one rebate of each type (two rebates total) per residential utility account

Terms & Conditions

- Rebates are distributed on a first-come, first-served basis until all funds are expended or through the program expiration date of June 30, 2026, whichever comes first.
- Rebates are for up to \$150 off newly purchased electric lawn care equipment (string trimmers, hedge trimmers, edgers, or tiller/cultivators) and/or up to \$150 off a newly purchased electric leaf blower.
- If Applicant elects to turn in a piece of gas-powered equipment, Applicant must drain the gas and the oil from the gas-powered equipment and dispose of it properly as household hazardous waste. Turning in equipment is optional.
- Limit of one rebate of each type (electric lawn care equipment and electric leaf blower) per residential utility account.
- Rebates may take up to eight (8) weeks to process.
- Rebates are issued as checks.

To Be Eligible for the Program

- Applicant must complete and sign the electric lawn care equipment & electric leaf blower rebate application and provide all requested material.
- Applicant must be a Redwood City resident. Applicant must provide a residential utility bill as proof of Redwood City residency. To ensure eligibility for rebate(s), verify eligibility with Public Works Services BEFORE purchasing new equipment.
- If applicant is not the property owner and is not listed on the utility account, applicant must provide the property owner or account holder's contact information.
- The electric lawn care equipment and/or electric leaf blower must be purchased between July 1, 2025 and June 30, 2026. The electric lawn care equipment & electric leaf blower rebate application must be submitted within 90 days of electric equipment purchase date(s).
- A copy of the original electric lawn care equipment and/or electric leaf blower receipt(s) must be included with the application. If applicant submits original receipt(s) and needs them returned, they must enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope with their application.
- **OPTIONAL:** Applicant may turn in gas-powered equipment, drained of fuel, along with application and original receipt(s), to Public Works Services, 1400 Broadway, Redwood City, CA 94063.

ELECTRIC LAWN CARE EQUIPMENT & ELECTRIC LEAF BLOWER REBATE PROGRAM APPLICANT CHECKLIST
